Academic Excellence and Intellectual Enhancement

Excellence in academics is the hallmark of any good institution and the announcement of the SSE & SSCE results made us all proud of our students.

Class XII result

Class XII result for the CBSE Board exam was declared on 12th May 2023. Master Farhan Muhammed became the National Topper scoring 99.6% in the Humanities stream. Archa Kiran and Thasneem Shajahan of the same stream scored 99%, Abin Sabu scored 98.6% and Gouri Ajith with 98.64 %. 28 students of the Humanities batch got 90% & above, 5 students scored 80% and above and 5 students got full A1. In the Science stream C. Aditya scored a percentage of 99.2. In the Science stream 43 students got 90% and above, 38 students scored 80% and above and 17 students scored 75% and above. Theertha Karma and Sidharth Sankar Pradeep Kumar scored 97.8 and 97.4 percentages respectively. Several of our students were placed in various prestigious institutions across the country. I take this occasion to congratulate these gems from SCV family, who hold our name aloft.

Class X Result

In the SSE **Class X results**, out of the 147 students, 76 students scored 90% and above, 46 students scored 80% and above, 11 of them scored 75% and above. Thus, scored a total of 133 distinction and 14 first class. Joshua Jacob Thomas became the school topper scoring 99.8%, followed by Malavika Suja and Shawn Jose with 98.8 % and 98.6% respectively. I thank each and every child for your dedication and untiring efforts that have taken Sarvodaya Central Vidyalaya to the towering heights of success and accomplishments .
